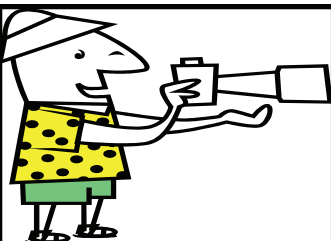

Come out to see how everyone else made out this year. There are always impressive horns to see.



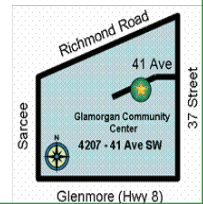

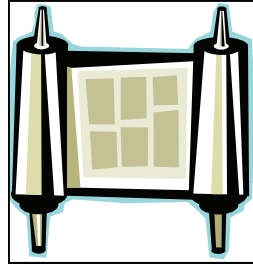
