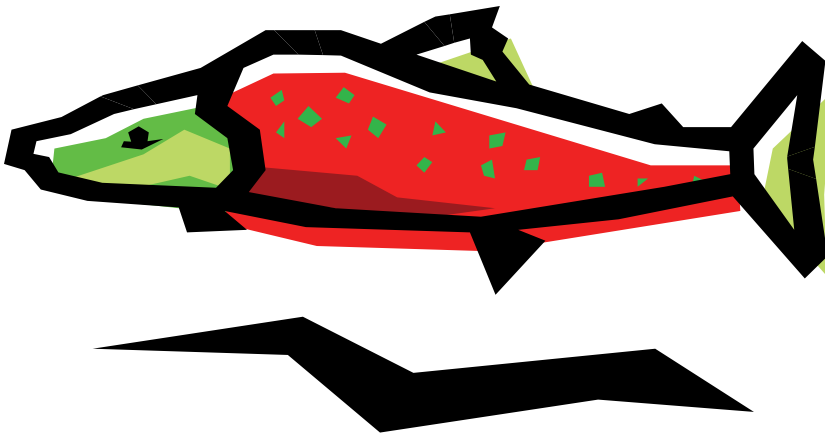

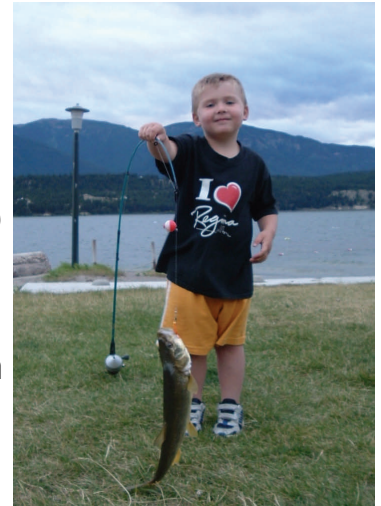


## Youth First Trophy Awards
